



TUITION SCHEDULE

Students applying for admission into Legacy Aviation Learning Center, Aviation Maintenance Technician School (AMTS) to earn their FAA Airframe & Powerplant (A&P) License will be expected to cover tuition, made payable to the Registrar's Office.

Tuition is all-inclusive: All aviation supplies, FAA exams (written, oral, practical), Tekton student toolkit, software licenses for interactive textbook (Ekanos), Transfr VR, test prep (Fulcrum Labs), and Learning Management System (Blackbaud).

Snap-On student toolkits are available for an extra \$2,000 fee and must be paid with the Enrollment Payment. Talk with your Admissions Representative to say if this is your preference.

All students should have their own lap-top computer, preferably a 2-in-1 tablet such as the Microsoft Surface for use at home, in the classroom, and the lab environment.

\$50: Application Fee (due at time of submittal)

Tuition Schedule

- \$500: Acceptance Deposit goes towards tuition (due at time of acceptance)
- May 8 - \$22,600*: Enrollment Payment, 60% of tuition, less the deposit (90 days before start on 8/6/24)
- December 18 - \$15,400: Balance Payment, 40% of tuition (90 days before Powerplant on 3/18/25)

*Students who pay in-full on May 8 will receive a \$500 discount, for a total of \$38,000.

Students have the option to select Snap-On tools instead of Tekton tools, but must pay the difference

Refunds

There is no trial period for students, and no refund for early withdrawal or a failing grade. However, a partial refund is available if the student gives a 90-day notice, allowing the Center time to backfill his/her open-seat.

- Students can make two payments, one that covers the first three terms General, Airframe 1 and Airframe 2 (\$23,100), and one that covers the last two terms Powerplant 1 and Powerplant 2 (\$15,400).
- Students have until 90 days in advance (12/18/24) to withdraw from starting Term 4 (3/18/25) to avoid paying the balance payment of \$15,400, or to receive a partial refund of \$15,400 if they paid in-full.
- If a refund is requested on or after 12/18/24 the Center will expect full payment.

Students can get a license in Airframe, or Powerplant, or Airframe & Powerplant (A&P). Most students want to obtain their A&P certifications as the combo is much more valuable to their career opportunities and advancement. Placing the refund between the end of Airframe and the start of Powerplant gives students a credential, and thus is where we draw the line.
